Year 6 Health Programme 2025/26

Healthy Futures is provided by Compass and works closely with Warwickshire Child and Family Wellbeing Service, providing high quality health promotion service to children and young people. Warwickshire Child and Family Wellbeing Service is commissioned by Public Health Warwickshire.

Good health is linked to educational attainment; therefore the healthier children are, the more likely they are to attend school regularly, focus and participate in lessons and achieve their potential. In line with government guidelines, all Year 6 children in Warwickshire are offered an anonymised online public health needs assessment. All questionnaires collected are stored securely on electronic patient systems. Data from the completed health questionnaires enables population based Public Health reports to be developed which are shared with schools and mental health in school teams (MHST). These reports enable us to support schools in working with families to address the health and wellbeing needs of pupils. The public health reports identify 3 school health priorities which enable Healthy Futures to work in partnerships with schools to work in partnership with schools and other agencies to deliver public health interventions. Interventions could include classroom lessons on oral health, internet safety or puberty. All data is anonymised and collated prior to being shared with other agencies e.g. Public Health Warwickshire, Schools.
